Energy Performance Certificates...

A few of your questions answered

Q: Energy Performance Certificates- how will they affect my building?

In April 2008 new legislation came into force requiring all commercial buildings for sale or rent over 10,000sqm to have an Energy Performance Certificate (EPC). The legislation is being phased in from April 2008 onwards so that by 1st October 2008 all non-dwellings over 50sqm will require an EPC. An intermediate date has also been set within the schedule that from 1st July 2008 all buildings for sale or rent over 2500sqm will require an EPC. The EPC will rate the energy performance of the building and will make specific recommendations as to how improvements can be made. Whereas it is expected that EPCs will help reduce carbon emissions and as such benefit the environment, it is also thought the biggest benefit to businesses will be to the bottom line. Savings in energy consumption will soon be helping increase profits.

Q: So do I need to get another EPC within 10 years?

EPC's are valid for 10 years. However should the activity type or internal building layout change within this timeframe then this may significantly affect the rating of the building. This may include an extensive refurbishment programme such as new building services installed.

Q: What steps should I take to obtain an EPC?

Only accredited energy performance certificate specialists can award EPCs. The Communities and Local Government have recently approved several training providers including the Building Research Establishment (BRE) and Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors (RICS). It has been estimated that approximately 2000 assessors will be required nationwide to undertake EPC's for commercial buildings. Five members of staff at Wilbourn Associates are qualified and will be able to produce Energy Performance Certificates whatever type of property you have and wherever you are located.

Q: What will an EPC assessor report on?

The energy performance certificate expert assessing your building will take detailed records as part of the site inspection. The assessor's attention will focus on elements directly responsible for the energy performance of your building. Areas to be investigated would include; general building construction, roof and wall insulation, ventilation and air conditioning systems, boilers, glazing, and lighting. Once the site inspection is over, the energy performance certificate data is input into a computer database programme which calculates the results and provides a comparison against a reference value for a similar property. The final published report will provide all the energy performance certificate information you will need to improve the energy efficiency of your building.

Q: Is an Energy Performance Certificate for business properties the same as for residential properties?

The non dwelling energy performance certificate will be of similar layout and design to the residential EPC. However, the commercial EPC will be calculated using the Simplified Building Energy Model (SBEM), a far more complex software programme than the residential EPC.
